June is Pride Month and also Refugee Month - research shows that LGBTQ+ young people make up around 24% of the young homeless population. On top of this, they are far more likely to be subjected to violence - both in and out of services. Centrepoint provide a safe space for LGBTQ+ young people to stay. Around 6% of young people at Centrepoint are refugees, including young people who have come to the UK as unaccompanied minors, fleeing violence or persecution in their own country. After being granted asylum, young people sometimes find themselves with nowhere to go and can end up on the streets. Centrepoint provides immigration advice and a place to live for up to 2 years, helping young people into independence.
